Use the checklist below to get your home spring-ready.

Install new batteries in smoke alarms & carbon monoxide detectors		Check siding & masonry for damage & schedule repairs
Test & dust all detectors		Remove storm windows & install screens
Replace furnace filter		Repair/replace damaged window screens
Inspect bathroom & kitchen caulking— re-caulk as needed		Inspect caulking around windows—if cracking recaulk
Test kitchen & bathroom exhaust fans		Check roof for damage & schedule reroofing if needed
Clean kitchen exhaust hood & filter	_	
Vacuum refrigerator coils	Ш	Check attic for leaks, mould, moisture intrusion, fire hazards & critters
Schedule air conditioning inspection		Get rid of surface mould with Concrobium Mold Control®

Clean gutters, check for leaks & make sure they are attached securely		Schedule annual dryer exhaust cleaning & check up
Clean & seal deck (if needed)		Check water heater for leaks (schedule inspection if older than 5 years)
